ABSTRACTS GUIDELINES:

AIM OF THE CONVOCATORY

This event aims to recognize excellence in young researchers as manifested in oral and poster presentations, encouraging the development of a collaboration between the two areas of CIBER: CIBER-BBN and CIBERESP. Being the main aim, the development of basic and translational research in the fields of Bioengineering, Biomaterials and Nanomedicine, Epidemiology and Public Health.

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

The call is open to undergraduate and master' students, predoctoral and postdoctoral (no more than 5 years from PhD defense) researchers who belong to a CIBER-BBN/CIBERESP group.

Participants who are not part of CIBER-BBN/CIBERESP should include in the email the head of their group (who must be a CIBER-BBN/CIBERESP member).

SELECTION PROCESS

The CIBER-BBN and CIBERESP Scientific Committee will make the selection of abstracts for oral and poster presentations by October 17th 2022. Participants will receive an email with the committee decision on the abstract and further instructions on the presentation format (if selected).

The best abstracts from each TOPIC will be selected for Oral Presentation.

Please note that if the abstract is accepted for oral or poster presentation, the assistance of the presenting author is mandatory.

BEST ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATION AWARD

The selected researchers from each TOPIC will be able to present their work during the I Young Researchers Meeting, participating in the contest for the best oral and poster presentation.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

Abstracts should be done following the template provided and must be sent by email to jornadasESP-BBN@ciber-bbn.es by not later than September 30th, 2022 (included) in word format indicating in the mail subject the information detailed in the present ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FORM.
